The material (Intro & Stages 1-4) in the "Turkish Language Program" manual *IS* the language program! Everything else just fleshes it out -- resources to make it work for you. The Program manual is what you need to get an overview and to learn how to best jump in. And throughout language study, keep referring back to the relevant Stages (and to the Introduction) to remind yourself of useful guidelines, principles and methods.

## We do ask a couple of things:

- 1) Please respect the copyrights that exist within it the Talkin Turkey language program (PILAT-MTI, Greg Thomson, Lonna Dickerson, Pollard). You may charge for copies to recoup your duplicating costs. However, to modify copyrighted sections, or to sell Talkin Turkey (or any modification of it that contains copyrighted material) for a profit, you must obtain the permission of the copyright holders. - 2) The publisher of Pollard's *Teach Yourself Turkish* granted permission to record the dialogues and make them available *to those using the book*, even though they also sell their own CD recordings of the dialogues. So please do not distribute the TalkinTurkey recordings separately from the program or use them without acquiring the book!
- 3) If you do change our materials, please make it clear that your version is modified. Others who see it may want to know whether it is the actual TalkinTurkey program or not, and where/how it's different.
- 4) If you make it better or add more helpful resources, we'd love to hear from you! There's always room for improvement, and we can gain from each other. (Feedback about typos/mistakes would also be greatly appreciated.)

\* If you need to print partial files or edit any files, select and copy the desired portion, paste it into a new Word document and save that file. The TalkinTurkey title font (TimesScrDLig) has been embedded in the Word documents on the CD so that the headings will show up properly; this is why a read-only message will come up even if you have copied the Word documents from the CD onto your hard drive. If you create a new Word document and your headings don't look the same as they do on the CD, you will need to install the TimesScrDLig TrueType font file from this CD onto your computer.
