

## Comparative Indexes of Grammar Points

The chart on pages 2–4 is ordered according to the Pollard\* *Teach Yourself Turkish* book (used for the grammar thread of the program), showing where in other resources to find more in-depth explanations of the grammar points.

Pages 5-17 are ordered according to the DLI lesson numbers. The final three pages contain some extra notations.

\* The material in all 16 units of the Pollard *Teach Yourself Turkish* book is the same in the 2003 edition as in the 1996 edition. The formatting has been updated and a few things added to the introductory and end reference material. The pagination has been redone so that page 1 is now the beginning of Unit 1, rather than the Introduction (which now has Roman numerals).
