They will still need all of the books for the Basic Kit except Lewis’ *Teach Yourself Turkish* (see the *Books and Materials* file, under *Getting Started*). The *LAMP* book is optional, depending on how much other instruction they will receive about setting up, taping and practicing drills and exercises.

Look in the *How to Put the Printed Manuals Together* file (under *Getting Started*) for instructions about printing and assembling the manuals. You may want to buy a thinner binder for the *General Resources*, depending on how many of the optional files you choose to print.
